If you are an experienced nurse from outside the U.S., you may be eligible for the **Immigrant Nurse Credentialing Program**



QUALIFICATIONS

- Equivalent education to a registered nurse in the U.S.
- Must be authorized to work in the U.S.
- Must be eligible for federal public benefits
- Worked as a nurse for at least 6 months outside the U.S.
- English language proficiency as measured by TOEIC, TOEFL or IELTS testing
- Ability to meet the Oregon State Board of Nursing qualifications

The Immigrant Nurse Credentialing (INC) Program will focus on preparing nurses for licensure and practice in the U.S.

The INC Program is an approved Oregon State Board of Nursing Registered Nurse re-entry program.
