- ◆ Parent Child Interaction (PCI) Program serves families and children 0-5 years old in Multnomah, Clackamas, Washington and Malheur Counties.
- ◆ PCI program helps parents to build on their learning on the importance of parent-child interaction through playing, book reading and many other activities to help prepare your child for school.
- ◆ Enrolled families will be provided with a Family Advocate who will facilitate home visits with the family. PCI program will use an evidence-based curriculum; Parents As Teachers (PAT). Families will be offered 2 visits and 1 group meeting each month. Enrolled parents and children will also have the opportunity to explore and meet other families on educational field trips.
